OUR TUTORS

Amazing GrAdes tutors are individually responsible and liable for their conduct while working with your child. We screen them based on their knowledge, experience, professionalism, and personality. We thoroughly check references, and all tutors are checked for criminal histories.

THE GIDEON MATH & READING PROGRAM

<u>This program is recommended for students in grades Pre-K through 5th</u>. This is a long-term program developed to <u>supplement</u> school programs and <u>fortify</u> academic foundations. For the maximum benefit, the student and parent should follow the recommendations of the instructors and perform a small amount of daily work. Although academic changes (which are typically seen in fewer careless errors and better homework discipline) often appear after a few weeks, progress is much more evident after a longer period of study. Students maximize their progress with regular class attendance, consistent completion of work, and the support of the parents.

Each student may attend classes **two** out of the following pre-scheduled days:

Mondays	4:00-6:00pm (by appointment only)	
Tuesdays	3:30pm-6:30pm	
Wednesdays	4:00pm-6:00pm (by appointment only)	
Thursdays	3:30-6:00pm	

Students will attend classes for at least 20 minutes per subject per session. Students participating in upper level programs will attend for at least 30 minutes per session. You must schedule your child's sessions and he or she is expected to arrive promptly. Make up sessions due to absences are not guaranteed and depend on class capacity on the requested make up day.

A minimum of 3 months is required. Termination of program will still require your account to be drafted for the 3-month minimum. *Thirty days' notice of termination is required*. Prepaid tuition is non-refundable.

MONTHLY TUITION (FLAT RATE)

The chart below lists our GIDEON tuition:

- Tuition may be pro-rated by weekly increments only but will be rounded to a minimum of one full week. Therefore, if you enroll after the 15th of the month, you will be charged for one month plus the additional weeks ofthe following month.
- Testing Fee: Students will be tested in both math and reading at a fee of \$75 perchild.
- Registration fees for GIDEON is \$50 for first subject or \$75 for both subjects if enrolled at the same time for the same student.
- <u>Accelerated Study</u> or attendance more than twice a week requires additional fees. Attending fewer than twice a week does not diminish tuition as curriculum is provided for each day.
- <u>Absence</u> for more than 60 continuous days requires a new registration fee <u>and</u> testing.
- <u>Termination of Program</u>: Thirty days written notice must be given prior to termination of program. Pre-paid tuition is non- refundable.
- <u>Childcare Fee</u>: Your child must be picked up within 15 minutes of completing classwork. **Parents who pick up their child after the time limit will be charged \$25 per 15-minute interval after the required pick up time**.

PREPARATION

If a student is unprepared, the session may be reduced in length or cancelled at the discretion of the instructor and will be billed at the normal rate.

Be committed. We will achieve the best results when all parties- students, parents, and tutors- are fully committed to this process before you begin your program.

Although Amazing GrAdes Tutoring has an extensive hiring and training process, we cannot guarantee results. Effective communication is essential to achieving your educational goals. PAYMENT

- Initial payments in the form of check, cash, or money order should be <u>hand delivered</u> (please do NOT mail)to **our office** during our business hours prior to the start date.
- Initial payment for testing, registration, first month's tuition, and any pro-rated weeks will be accepted by check, cash, or money order and should be delivered in person to: Amazing GrAdes Tutoring, 1460
 T.L. Townsend Road, Rockwall, Texas 75032, prior to beginning of attendance. Subsequent monthly tuition shall be paid by automatic credit (separate form provided) unless a 1 month deposit is made.
- Credit card information must be kept on file in case of any debt owed to the company. Credit card will not be charged if payments are complete or cash is given in person.
- All tuition is due on the 28th of the previous month and shall be automatically debited by Amazing Grades Tutoring administrative staff between the 28th of the previous month and the 3rd of the tuition month. A late fee of \$ 25 shall be assessed on all payments that do not clear before the 3rd of said tuition month.
